

- An adequate period may be imposed by the Principal / Vice Principal for absences from school which cannot be to any further extent justified.
- Students should come to school in complete uniform. They must be always clean and tidy.
- Every student should be diligent in accomplishing the home works and other assignment that are given to them.
- Students are responsible for the save custody of their own books and belongings. Each article should be marked with the student's name.
- Students are to address their teachers and all members of the school staff with due respect and politeness.
- Students should also be polite among themselves speaking gently to one another and behaving in a friendly and loving manner.
- Any damage to school property is to be compensated by the students involved.
- During the academic session three vacations are allowed - summer, Durga Puja and Winter. Students must be punctually present on the reopening day after each vacation.
- No parents or visitors are allowed to talk to the teachers during class hours. During class hours, No parents are allowed to go and see their wards.
- Close co-operation between the parents and the school authorities is absolutely essential for the proper development of the students in school. Parents and guardians are always welcome to the school to discuss any problem of their child at the time fixed for such meetings or at other times, by a previous appointment.
